HUSQVARNA VIKING CLASS REGISTRATION: Please register for all classes in the Viking Sewing Center. Register in person, by mail, or phone using a credit card, check or cash. **There are no refunds on classes, but if you cancel at least 2 days in advance, you will be issued a store credit for another class or to purchase store merchandise. If we cancel a class, a full refund will be given or you may transfer the fee to another class.**

SEWING FUNDAMENTALS FOR ADULTS

The following classes are designed for the beginning sewer. Each class builds on the previous class but you are free to pick the classes that interest you and fit your skill level. Each class teaches sewing techniques so even if the item you might be making isn't of particular interest; you are learning techniques that can be applied to many other sewing projects.

#1 - INTRODUCTION TO SEWING

This class is a demonstration/practice class to teach the most basic sewing techniques. You need this class if you did not take owner's classes when you purchased your sewing machine or you don't own a sewing machine and have not sewn before. We will talk about basic sewing supplies and their uses and will make a sample notebook of basic sewing stitches and their uses.

#2 – BASIC SEWING – ZIPPERED COSMETIC BAG

This first sewing project will teach you how to insert a zipper and help you practice straight sewing. Designed with enough space for your make-up, this bag has an inside pocket, a simple zipper installation and is perfect for nights away from home or organizing in a bigger bag. **You must have taken owner's classes or Fundamental #1 Introduction to Sewing in order to enroll in this class.**

#3 – BASIC HOME DECORATING – FLANGE PILLOW

Create a beautiful pillow for your sofa or bed in fabrics that complement your décor. You will learn how to sew in a zipper and make a flange around the outer edge. **You must have taken owner's classes or Fundamentals #1 Introduction to Sewing in order to enroll in this class.**

#4 – BASIC GARMENT CONSTRUCTION – PAJAMA PANTS, CASUAL PANTS OR SHORTS

In this class you will learn how to use a commercial pattern to make pajama bottoms, casual pants or shorts. After this class you can make a pair for everyone in the family. Everyone loves wearing these comfortable pants. **Basic sewing skills are necessary for this class.**

#5 – BASIC GARMENT CONSTRUCTION CONTINUED – MAKING A BLOUSE

After making the pajama bottoms you can join this class and learn how to make a blouse, Setting in sleeves and collar are important skills needed in garment construction and making buttonholes can be a challenge, but not after this class. **You must have basic sewing skills and have taken Fundamentals #4 Basic Garment construction to enroll in this class.**

CHILDRENS BASIC SEWING CLASSES

LEVEL ONE, Pillowcase and Tote Bag

Great class for the novice sewer who wants to learn the basics. During this class your child will first make a pillowcase and then a tote bag, while learning to control the machine and sew straight.

Bring that serger in and we will teach you how to clean it, oil it, change a needle, how to thread it and how to use it. Finally get some use out of that machine and have fun doing it.

Made almost completely on the serger it requires that you have taken a Quilting on a Serger Class and be comfortable with your serger and adjusting tensions, threading and specialty threads.

ADULT BEGINNING QUILTING-Around the World Quilt Pattern

For those of you who have been hesitant to try quilting this class is perfect for you. We start with the basics including equipment, choosing fabric, rotary cutting correctly, piecing, assembling and quilting your finished lap sized quilt. You need to know how to use your sewing machine to enroll in this class.

NEW!! SEW WITH YOUR FEET CLASS

This class is a fun way to learn all about the accessory feet that are available for your **Husqvarna Viking Sewing Machines**. Each class in the series will use different feet and you will be creating a quilt square each month. You don't need to own the feet we are highlighting each week to attend. At the end of eight weeks you can put the squares together in a wall hanging or quilt and we will help you to do that. This is a nine week class and size is limited to 10 only. If you have to miss a class you can pick it up in the make-up classes we will offer at the end of the series.. You must have finished your owner's classes before attending these classes as you need to know how to use your machine first. We will supply our fabric and trims in our color scheme, but if you wish to use your own fabric instead you are welcome to.
